# From the Chair



Triangle Land Conservancy remains an innovative leader for local conservation, even as we navigate the economic challenges around us. We have developed strong partnerships, bringing deeper meaning to the phrase "more than the sum of its parts." We also have not hesitated to change the way we work in order to maximize the impact we are able to make with the resources we have.

Funding shortfalls and new constraints on local, county and state governments have meant many traditional sources of funds for conservation work have all but disappeared for now. Nonetheless, our important work is going forward because we all believe it is too important to lose the momentum we have spent so much energy to create.

For example, toward the end of the 2010-11 fiscal year, the Triangle Lakes Project began to take shape. TLC, along with other conservation organizations, reached out to local public officials to create a dedicated source of funding to be used to conserve land along our region's waterways to safeguard drinking water quality. This makes fiscal sense because preventing pollution is 27 times more cost effective than cleaning it up. As a result of this effort, the cities of Raleigh and Durham took unprecedented steps to make money available to protect land that safeguards water quality. Officials from the Orange Water and Sewer Authority and the Town of Cary are also exploring ways to support the Triangle Lakes Project.

The Irvin Nature Preserve is buzzing with activity connecting people to nature. The preserve is home to the Healthy Choices Garden, where fresh fruits and vegetables are growing for our region's hungry, and refugees from Burma are growing delicious food that reminds them of home. The garden, made possible through the support of our members and grants from the Blue Cross Blue Shield of North Carolina Foundation, Strowd Roses, Inc., the Cannon Foundation and the Highland Vineyards Foundation, is an alliance of TLC, the Orange County Partnership for Young Children and the Inter-Faith Food Shuttle. These grants also made a new processing shed a reality, providing a place to clean food on site, and a greenhouse for starting the next season's crops. And we have completed our third year in partnership with Irvin Learning Farm, connecting area children with nature through camps, afterschool programs and workshops led by an esteemed group of thoughtful and talented teachers.

We are working toward better wildlife habitat on our conservation lands. We completed several habitat restoration activities this past year, including work at our Horton Grove Nature Preserve. We are in the process of re-establishing a Piedmont prairie and improving forest habitat there.

All of these successes are only possible thanks to you, our members and friends.

Last year, our members successfully completed the *Our Water, Our Land* capital campaign, creating the Pearson Stewart Land Opportunity Fund. This revolving fund provides ready cash to complete conservation projects on a landowner's timetable rather than waiting for funding through various grant cycles. This year, the fund was used to pay costs for more than half of our completed projects, making it possible to continue conserving land during a tight budget year. TLC is reimbursed for these payments, replenishing the fund. To date, the Pearson Stewart Land Opportunity Fund has led to 43 transactions protecting 3,752 acres.

And your continued gifts to our Annual Fund allow us to keep our doors open and our staff working hard to save the places we love here in the Triangle. Without this day-to-day support, we would not be able to continue our work as an innovative conservation leader.

As this letter goes to press, *BusinessWeek* has released the results of their survey of the best cities in America in which to live. One of the "headline" reasons for Raleigh's #1 ranking is green space, an acknowledgement of something that TLC has long believed—that the benefits of open space create value for the entire community and are a critical component of an attractive, sustainable economy.

On behalf of TLC's Board of Directors and staff, thank you for your support and dedication to your local land trust!



# **UPPER NEUSE CLEAN** WATER INITIATIVE

Through this multi-organization initiative, TLC and partners are conserving land along streams and wetlands in the Upper Neuse watershed to protect nine drinking water supplies, including Falls Lake, that together serve more than a half-million people. For TLC, the area includes our former Little River Conservation Initiative, where we still focus our work while seeking partnership opportunities with local and county government agencies, and conservation nonprofits in other areas.



# Morgan Creek Floodplain Forest

The two components of this project include a donation of 103 acres in Chatham County, and more than 20 acres in Durham County donated as a conservation easement. The Durham County portion is part of the Morgan Creek Floodplain Forest Significant Natural Heritage Area; TLC will receive full ownership of this conservation land in five years. This is the second project for TLC that includes a mitigation bank in compliance with Durham's storm water ordinance. The project provides habitat for many species of wildlife, and serves to increase the important buffer around Jordan Lake.

# Reimer Nature Preserve







In northern Orange County, the 100+ acres of the Susan and Keith Reimer Nature Preserve were donated to TLC by Mrs. Reimer. Transaction costs were provided by the Upper Neuse Clean Water Initiative, because this preserve protects the water quality of the upper Neuse watershed.

This mostly forested preserve features two tributaries of the South Fork of the Little

River. The forest not only protects water quality, but also offers significant habitat for local wildlife. Although it is not open to the public, TLC will offer outings to this location, thereby providing opportunities for people to connect with the natural world.

# Shop Hill 🍇 🕍 🚄







In a two-phase process, D.R. Bryan and Arlenpark, LLC generously donated conservation easements of roughly 180 acres, part of a 290-acre parcel they own in the Treyburn area of Durham County. The conservation land was zoned industrial, and was on track to be sold for commercial development. Instead, this land, which contains several unnamed tributaries of the Little River and important upland hardwood forests, will now be forever conserved, thus protecting water quality and providing highquality habitat for wildlife. This land is also significant as part of the original 30,000-acre Historic Stagville Plantation.

Transaction costs for the project were provided by a grant from the Healthy Forests Initiative, in which TLC participates with its Upper Neuse partners. Acquisition of this conservation easement connects the northernmost portions of our Horton Grove Nature Preserve to the most southerly portions of our Snow Hill projects—providing over five linear miles of protected conservation land.



# **COMMUNITY LANDS**

# Flower Hill (Lampe) 🍇 🚂 👔



In Johnston County, TLC's smallest nature preserve grew to 30 acres this year through the donation of four acres by Lampe & Malphrus Lumber Company in Smithfield, and a purchase by TLC of 7.4 additional acres.

Funding through a Clean Water Management Trust Fund grant combined with support from a grant from the NC Attorney General's Office of Environmental Enhancement made the donation possible. TLC thanks Lampe & Malphrus Lumber Company for their generous donation to this important natural area.

Flower Hill Nature Preserve is named for a stand of rhododendron that grows along the north-facing bluffs of Moccasin Creek. This population of rhododendron (common to our mountains, but not to the Triangle) is believed to be the easternmost one in North Carolina. The newly donated land provides important buffer protection for these bluffs, and offers wildlife habitat along Tabron Spring Branch, a small tributary to Moccasin Creek that begins on the newly donated tract. Moccasin Creek is a major tributary of the Buckhorn Reservoir, the primary drinking water supply for the City of Wilson.

The forest growing along the creek in this newly donated tract protects water quality by slowing runoff and reducing sedimentation. TLC plans to add new trails for public access to this special place as we continue to work with other landowners around Flower Hill to further protect a unique landscape.

# Snow Hill Preserve (addition) 🎑 🔣



In Durham County, Terry Sanford, Jr. and his wife, Laurie, donated one acre on Snow Hill Road. It is contiguous with TLC's Snow Hill Preserve and will be used as a future access point to the preserve. This land provides additional habitat for local wildlife, and offers increased opportunities for people to connect with nature while visiting the Snow Hill Preserve.

# **MARKS CREEK**

Through partnership in the Marks Creek Rural Lands Initiative, TLC is working to protect 7,500 acres of farmland, forest and wetlands. The partners are promoting parks, greenways and connections to the Mountains-to-Sea Trail from neighboring communities.

# Marks Creek Floodplain Forest 🚨 🕌 🕺








In June of this year, TLC acquired from Olivia West 85 acres of forest and wetlands that straddle the Johnston-Wake County line. This tract adds to more than 1,500 acres already protected within the Marks Creek watershed in these counties. Marks Creek empties into the Neuse River, the drinking water source for Johnston County, making protection of this land a high priority.

The Marks Creek Floodplain Forest, which is mostly in Johnston County, includes a conservation easement held by the State of North Carolina that protects over 3,900 feet of Marks Creek and portions of four unnamed streams that feed into Marks Creek. The northern portion of the property is designated as a Significant Natural Heritage Area, because of the absence of development along the stream and its good water quality, which has historically supported the Least Brook Lamprey, a species of State Special Concern.

Acquisition of this land ensures clean water downstream for Johnston County residents, and protects important wildlife habitat. Although the property will not immediately be open to the public, long-term goals include plans to incorporate it into a regional network of trails and parks, including a possible trail connection to the Mountains-to-Sea Trail along the Neuse River, thus enhancing opportunities to connect people with the natural world.

Funding for the project was provided by a grant from the NC Clean Water Management Trust Fund and the NC Attorney General's Office through an Environmental Enhancement Grant. TLC thanks these funding sources for partnering with us to conserve this special place.





# **WORKING LANDS**

# Bull Branch Farm 🚨 🗯 🍱





In Johnston County, TLC placed a conservation easement on 287 acres of this working farm owned by Phil and Earline Bunn. The easement protects land that produces tobacco, corn, soybeans, wheat, and sweet potatoes. It also protects wildlife habitat and several streams that flow into Moccasin Creek, one of the main tributaries feeding Buckhorn Reservoir, a drinking water supply for the City of Wilson. Funding was provided by the North Carolina Agricultural Development and Farmland Preservation Trust Fund.

# Holding Family Lands 🚨 🗯 🖼







In Johnston County, TLC worked with the Holding Family to place two working lands conservation easements on this family farm. The easements include streams that empty into Buffalo Creek and the Neuse River. The tracts also include forest and agricultural land, where tobacco and soybeans are grown. These easements protect local water resources and food supply, and also provide important wildlife habitat.

# Magnolia Grove 🚨 🍱



In Orange County, Merrill Petrow donated a conservation easement to TLC that protects 30 acres along a stretch of Neville Creek, which is approximately a half mile upstream from University Lake, a drinking water reservoir for Chapel Hill and Carrboro. Because this is a conservation easement, TLC does not own the property, and it is not open to the public. But the easement benefits us all by protecting our water quality, and by providing important habitat for local wildlife.







# **CONSERVATION EASEMENTS**

This year, TLC granted conservation easements on two conserved lands, which it already owned, to the Clean Water Management Trust Fund (CWMTF). This process replenished the Pearson Stewart Land Opportunity Fund, making money available for future conservation projects. The Land Opportunity Fund allows TLC to complete projects on the landowner's timeline rather than waiting for grant funding or other sources to fall into place. Protection of Snow Hill IV and White Pines (Williams Tract) would not have happened without this public funding from CWMTF.

# **Snow Hill IV**

Snow Hill IV in Durham County is a dramatic piece of conservation land adjoining the Little River. It was once part of the Johnson and Bennehan Plantations, which, in their day, covered almost all of northern Durham County. This land is bisected by the Historic Catawba Indian Trading Path, and also contains the oldest known grave in Durham County. Conservation of these agricultural lands and forests protects food sources for our local community and habitat for wildlife. It also helps to protect the water quality of the region, while offering opportunities for people to connect with the natural world.

# White Pines (Williams Tract)

In Chatham County just south of Pittsboro, the 85-acre Williams Tract is less than a mile from TLC's White Pines Nature Preserve. Although it is not river-front property, the Williams Tract does contain the headwaters of several tributaries that flow into the Deep River, thereby serving to protect water quality. This tract expands the protection of the nationally significant White Pines Nature Preserve to 374 acres of forestland and wildlife habitat. Although this tract is not currently open to the public, it serves to enhance our connection to the natural world by helping to buffer the White Pines Nature Preserve, which is open to visitors.

# **STEWARDSHIP**

Stewardship activities for TLC vary from season to season and place to place. A multitude of factors influence how TLC staff manage each preserve or open land, including the habitat type, public use, surrounding land use and changing environmental conditions. Significant stewardship activities this year included...

# **Horton Grove Nature Preserve**

Our goal at Horton Grove Nature Preserve is to provide a variety of habitats for our native plants and animals. This past year, we cleared an overgrown field as the first step toward establishing a native prairie at the Horton Grove Nature Preserve north of Durham. Work is continuing to remove invasive species and stump sprouts, and the field will be burned this winter. Following the burn, native plants will be reintroduced to this land by collecting seeds locally and planting them at the site.

We also thinned an overcrowded loblolly forest susceptible to insect infestation, and we cut eight acres of loblolly pine to create an early successional habitat for ground nesting birds. This habitat complements the neighboring federal lands at Falls Lake, which is managed by the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission. Habitat for ground nesting birds is in short supply in the NC Piedmont, and increasing this habitat type is a priority in the State Wildlife Action Plan. We also thinned the density of six acres to encourage growth of a mature oak-hickory hardwood forest.

An interpretive trail will guide hikers through these habitats when the preserve opens in 2012. This project is supported by a Partners for Fish and Wildlife Program multi-year grant from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and a Community Firewise and Urban Interface Grant from the NC Forest Service.

# Weedwackers

Invasive exotic plant species—plants not native to North Carolina—are a threat to




habitat throughout the Triangle. Because they have no natural predators or diseases here, they spread fast, overtaking our natural areas, displacing native species, and reducing the biodiversity native plants and animals evolved to rely on.

TLC has gathered a group of volunteers, the Weedwackers, to help identify and control these threats to conserving our special places. This past year, they have concentrated their efforts on Johnston Mill Nature Preserve and Irvin Nature Preserve. This program is funded in part by the Community Firewise and Urban Interface Grant Program from the NC Forest Service.

# **Corporate/Educational Work Days**

In addition to TLC's individual volunteers, many corporate and educational groups helped TLC with a variety of tasks.

Students from Duke's Law School, Durham Academy, NC State University Natural Resources class, Raleigh Charter High School and Chapel Hill homeschool students worked on a variety of tasks including trail work and invasive plant removal. Employees of Centrex, Monsanto and the Redwoods Group worked on trail building. We were also fortunate to have NC State, Duke University and UNC-Chapel Hill interns working on several stewardship projects.







# **TLC STEWARD PROGRAM**

We use the word steward a lot at Triangle Land Conservancy. From being a good steward, or caretaker, of our community's natural resources to stewarding, or caring, for the land we've protected. And being mindful of how we steward, or use, donations and funding that help us carry out our mission.

So it seems fitting that our monthly giving program is called the *TLC Steward* program. A growing

number of our 3,000 members and friends have decided to join by making a monthly credit card gift of \$10 or more. Those *TLC Steward* members are making an important impact on local conservation through their giving and demonstrating their commitment to TLC by providing a reliable source of monthly support.


